Seventy **NEW** chairs are coming back to Bronte Village and the Bronte Waterfront for summer 2019!

Paint your Oakville pride onto a Muskoka chair as part of the *At Home in Bronte*, - a creative, interactive public art enhancement to Bronte Village, a designated tourist area.

At Home in Bronte is offering artists, families, community groups and members of the corporate community the opportunity to paint a Muskoka chair. Applicants are encouraged to use their imagination and creativity to develop a creative chair design and application. Each chair will carry the name of the painter group and name of the chair.

How it works

1. Brainstorm with a group of co-workers, family members, friends or local community group and decide to apply to paint a chair.
2. Complete and submit this application (due: **Friday, April 26 @ 4 p.m.**)
3. Selected chair designers will be notified by email the week of April 29.

Paint groups must obtain their own necessary paint and painting materials, and must return their painted chair to Bronte Heritage Park for installation on June 19th. *Alternate transport arrangements can be made.

Describe Your Chair

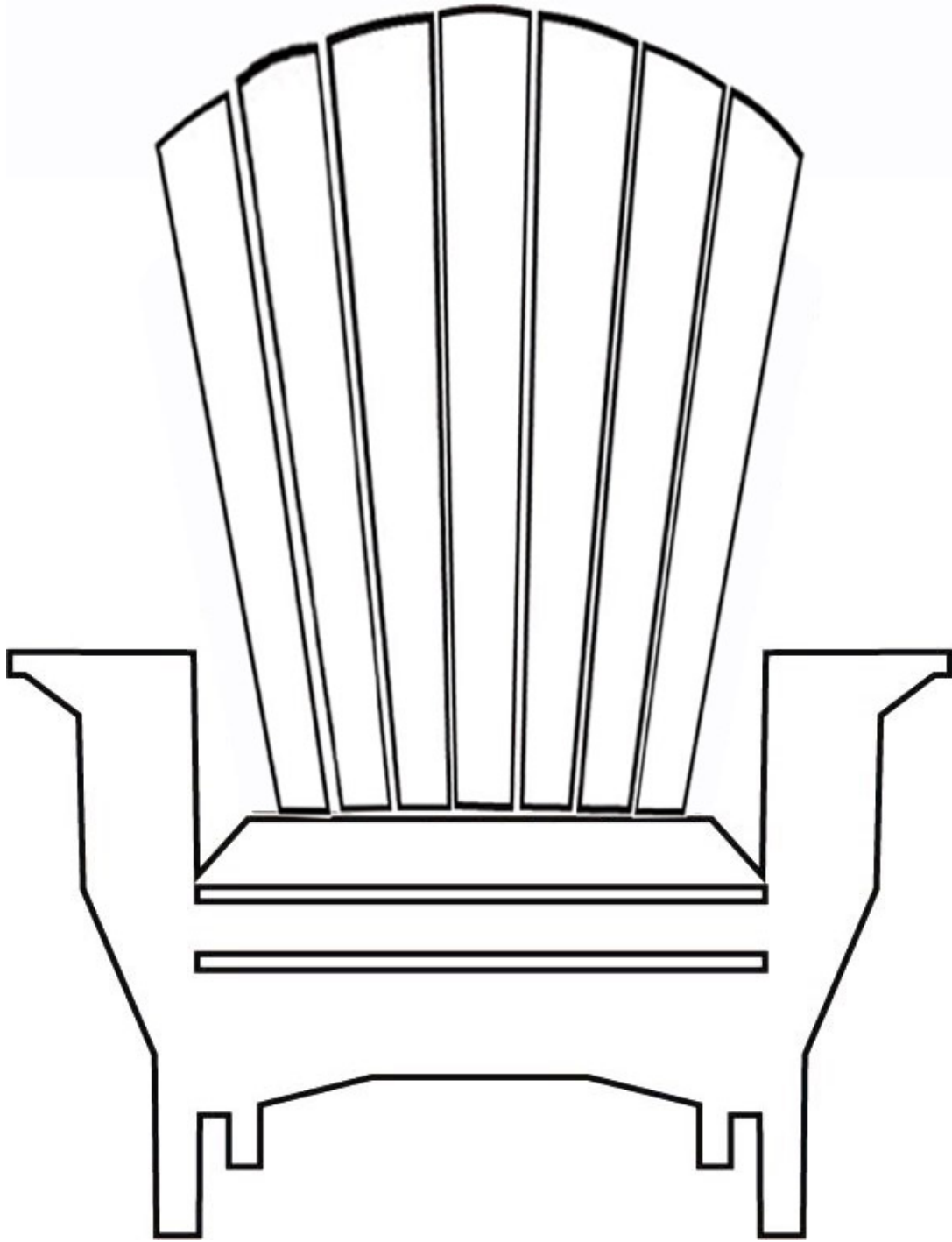
Each *At Home in Bronte* chair will help to showcase the community's collective pride of living, working and visiting in Oakville. The artwork on each individual chair is intended to share the experiences, perspectives, and stories of its artist(s).

Painting Group Rules:

- The Bronte Village BIA reserves the right to determine and select all chair painters, and determine after completion whether any chair is appropriate for display as part of the project.
- Chair designs may not contain offensive, obscene, profane, indecent or otherwise controversial content.
- Company logos to appear on the chair may not exceed a maximum design size of 4 inches by 4 inches. A maximum of two corporate logos may appear on the chair. Religious, political, logos as 'whole chair' design with logo will not be approved.
- Designs containing religious or political references, symbols, etc., will not be approved.
- Changes/additions to the structural design of the chair are not permitted. Materials other than paint cannot be applied/affixed to the chair.

Guiding themes for the design of the chairs include the following:

- Your own expression of love for the natural beauty of Bronte, Oakville
- Your vision of the joys of spring and summer
- What it means to live life to the full
- A personal message that inspires you
